## YOU NEED A PERMIT IF YOU ARE:

## All Businesses in Woodbridge Fire District #1

- Welding and/or cutting. (Examples: Soldering Pipe)
- Any permanent cooking operation that requires a suppression system.

## Woodbridge Center Mall

- Placing or constructing temporary kiosks, display booths or concession equipment.
- Temporarily using the mall as a place of assembly. (Examples: Special events in your store or in the common area of the Mall)
- Using open flame or flame producing devices.
- Displaying liquid or gas fueled powered equipment. (Example: Cars in the common area of mall)
- Using liquefied petroleum gas, liquefied natural gas, and compressed flammable gas in containers exceeding 5-pound capacity. (Examples: Jewelry stores or contractors working in the mall.)

Listed above is just an example of common permit requests, view the Permit Application to see the full list. If you are not sure if you need a permit please contact the Woodbridge Fire Prevention Bureau at 732-602-6040 between the hours of 8am-4pm Monday-Friday or e-mail us at FIRESAFE@WFDNJ01.ORG.

NOTE: If you are doing construction in your building, you should contact the Building Department @ 732-634-4500 for a permit. If you need a smoke alarm acceptance test when selling your home the Building Department should be contacted as well.
