Woodbridge Fire Prevention

Tot Finders are available at the Woodbridge Fire Prevention Bureau for children under the age of 10. The Tot Finder fire safety sticker is not a substitute for an effective home fire safety program and should include:

- Working smoke alarms on all levels of your home. Batteries should be changed TWO times a year (when you change your clocks change your batteries.)
- 2. Develop a home fire escape plan and practice it with all family members. (Even the little ones)
- 3. Practice home fire drills at least TWO times a year.



The new Tot Finder has been designed for the inside of the home, to deter any security issues. Old window Tot Finders should be removed and if a child under the age of 10 still sleeps in the room a new Tot Finder should be placed on the bedroom door. The new stickers are designed to be removed.

Any time the use of a child's bedroom changes, weather the child has grown or the family moves, these stickers should be removed to best aid firefighters. Tot Finders are just one part of your fire safety
