

Woodbridge Fire Prevention

Tot Finders

Tot Finders are available at the Woodbridge Fire Prevention Bureau for children under the age of 10. The Tot Finder fire safety sticker is not a substitute for an effective home fire safety program and should include:

1. Working smoke alarms on all levels of your home. Batteries should be changed **TWO** times a year (when you change your clocks change your batteries.)
2. Develop a home fire escape plan and practice it with all family members. (Even the little ones)
3. Practice home fire drills at least **TWO** times a year.



The new Tot Finder has been designed for the inside of the home , to deter any security issues. Old window Tot Finders should be removed and if a child under the age of 10 still sleeps in the room a new Tot Finder should be placed on the bedroom door. The new stickers are designed to be removed.

Any time the use of a child's bedroom changes, weather the child has grown or the family moves , these stickers should be removed to best aid firefighters. Tot Finders are just one part of your fire safety

plan, if a fire occurs in your home everyone should know what to do to get out safe. In the event a child does become trapped Tot Finders can assist Firefighters when searching your home but should not be relied on as your only plan . If you would like a Tot Finder please complete the 3 items listed above and show a copy of your fire escape plan to the Fire Prevention Bureau .
