They're not really worried about it because I know myself it is a different experience being down there on a nozzle and a flame might come up and you know how you put your hand in and one minute it's a problem and we really don't need that so I just wanted to put that out there. I know that there is a big caucus meeting tonight with the county so I know that the Volunteer Chief and the Volunteer Company is up there at that event so I guess that's why tonight we're a little bit light in the audience so I need a motion to go into Executive Session for legal and personnel matters.

RESOLUTION




